

TO ESTABLISH NEW FISHER HOUSE FOR WOUNDED WARRIORS AND VETERANS AT VA MEDICAL CENTER IN AUGUSTA, GA

The Combined KORUS Veterans Association (CKVA) and the US Federation of Korea Veterans Organizations (USFKVO) arranged to have Citations of the organizations to be awarded to Mrs. Judith L Knight, widow of a Korean War veteran and active member of several veterans support organizations. Mrs. Knight was instrumental in the initial meetings and funding campaigns to obtain this newest Fisher House at the Charlie Norwood VAMC, Augusta, GA. We recognize with pride the honors bestowed upon the Fisher House Foundation, and family, by President Bush and the VA in 2004, and note that the numbers of Fisher Houses (initial costs about \$500 million each) has steadily grown from 1990 to this newest, #56. As noted in the press account, the facilities are provided at no charge to support and help complete the healing of veterans, warriors, and their families, a gift of nearly \$165,000,000 dollars in savings to the individuals who have already paid so much to our Nation.
